

**ORANGEVILLE VILLAGE BOARD PUBLIC HEARING and SPECIAL MEETING
October 11, 2010**

(The following is a summary of proceedings; the official minutes are subject to approval at the next scheduled meeting.)

A hearing was held concerning the annexation of the property owned by Chad R. Parriott, 530 Freeport Street. Hearing no statements on the issue, the Board convened a special meeting to approve Mr. Parriott's request for annexation and to execute the annexation agreement as proposed in previous Board meetings.

**ORANGEVILLE VILLAGE BOARD JOINT REVIEW MEETING
November 22, 2010**

The Orangeville Village Board held its annual meeting to review TIF expenditures and discuss future plans with the other taxing bodies within Orangeville. Representatives from the Orangeville School District, Oneco Township, and County Board attended. Presiding officer Don Hoyle reviewed the Statements of Income and Retained Earnings for the twelve months ending April 30, 2011 and for the five months ending September 30, 2011. Mr. Hoyle reported that of \$484,000 currently available, \$150,000 will be reserved to pay off the sewer loan. Of the balance, \$136,000 is due for painting the water tower; \$60,000 is due on the EPA loan, \$59,800 is due to Civil Construction for the summer road projects; \$6700 is committed to the Fire Department for land purchase; and an estimated \$27,000 is committed to the School District to upgrade a restroom to ADA standards. The remaining TIF funds will be expended in next summer's road projects and Village Hall roof and furnace replacement.
