

Orangeville Village Board Meeting January 2, 2012

(The following is a summary of proceedings; the official minutes are subject to approval at the next scheduled meeting.)

Communications: Contract proposal from Mediacom has been received. Action is tabled pending review.

Committee Reports and Business:

Finance, Economic Development & Administration: The 2012 meeting calendar was approved. (Still 1st Monday of each month except Tues after Labor Day)

Public Safety: Crossing lights are installed and operating on Church Alley. The FEMA grant application for flood damage mitigation has gone forward with 8 property owners on Mill Street expressing interested in selling their properties to the Village should FEMA funds be granted this fall. Three owners expressed no interest in selling. The Village bought 2 parcels last summer as a match to the program. The Village plans appropriate development of flood plain land as recreational use and parking lots.

Streets & Public Sanitation: The bracket for the stop sign at the post office corner is on order.

Water & Sewer: The sewer line behind Dr Maly's office extending down to Richland Creek Foods was routed, repaired and inspected.

Building & Maintenance: A small leak at the chimney still exists through the Village Hall roof. The roofer has been notified. The ceilings on both floors are being painted, the basement walls repaired and painted, and the new furnace installed.

TIF: The Board approved an additional payment to the School District to replace old, frozen water valves encountered during the restroom rehab (\$575). This completes the Village's commitment to that project.

There is a Special Meeting on Monday, Jan 9, 2012 at 7pm at Village Hall to update the Strategic Plan.

The next regular board meeting is Monday, Feb 6, 2012 at 7pm at Village Hall.
