

ORANGEVILLE VILLAGE BOARD SPECIAL MEETING
January 9, 2012

(The following is a summary of proceedings; the official minutes are subject to approval at the next scheduled meeting.)

The Board held a special meeting to update the 5-year strategic plan, and to set priorities for this year's projects. After completing the projects still in progress, the highest priority projects are to re-apply for a transportation enhancement grant to light and streetscape High Street from Church St to the Jane Addams trailhead; acquire additional flood plain properties if FEMA funds are granted; remove the most dangerous old street trees; work with property owners to replace some of the worst sections of sidewalk; and pay down or refinance loans and bonds as we anticipate TIF expiration. Depending on the cost of the highest priority projects, we may be able start replacing old fire hydrants, start constructing amenities at Water Tower Park, and support capital improvements as requested from our partner taxing bodies.
